She is totally dependent on her daughter for her treatment of chemotherapy. Her prognosis is good.



#### Suvarna Hole

**Age:** 60 years

**Diagnosis:** Ca Breast Rt (Optd)

**Brief:** She is a housewife having three children, two boys working as rickshaw drivers & one as an electrician. She belongs to a poor income background. She is a needy patient and requires financial help. She is undergoing chemotherapy. Her prognosis is good.

## Report of Patients (Beneficiaries of Radiation Therapy) At CIMS



### Hasina Jamadar

**Age:** 51 years | **Diagnosis :** Ca Cervix

**Remarks:** She is a housewife. She belongs to a very low income group. She stays in a slum area and is in need of financial help. She has three children, daughter married, and two sons studying. Her husband met with an accident and is injured and is not working. She is very needy and poor and required financial help for her treatment. Her prognosis is good.

**Treatment Provided:** She has undergone six cycles of Chemotherapy at Vishranti Hospital. She has to undergo 25 sittings of Radiotherapy and three sitting of Brachytherapy.



### Lata Shinde

**Age:** 42 years | **Diagnosis:** Ca Breast

**Remarks:** She is a young patient having a child; her husband is working as a clerk in a private company. She lives in a slum area and belongs to a very poor family background. She has been advised Chemotherapy & Radiation Therapy. Her prognosis is good.

**Treatment Provided:** She has undergone eight cycles of Chemotherapy at Vishranti Hospital. She has to undergo 35 sittings of Radiotherapy.

### Ambulance Van Launch

BMC Software and Live Life Love Life Charity Foundation Inaugurated its First Ambulance To Be Used By Prayas Health Group.

Live Life Love Life Charity Foundation (LLLLCF), working for the welfare of underprivileged cancer patients with the help of BMC Software India Pvt. Ltd. generously invested in a new ambulance van on Monday, 20th February 2017. This ambulance van will be used by Prayas Health Group for mobile cervical cancer screening camps in the rural areas on the outskirts of Pune for women who cannot afford a medical check-up at hospitals. Prayas Health Group is one of the beneficiaries of the donations Live Life Love Life Charity Foundations.

The inauguration took place at Malaka Spice, the inspired Southeast Asian restaurant by Praful Chandawarkar, the Co-founder of Live Life Love Life Charity Foundation. Cervical cancer is a preventable cancer. It is caused by a long-standing infection with Human papillomavirus (HPV). We now have 2 powerful tools to prevent cervical cancer. They are HPV vaccination of adolescent girls and cervical cancer screening. But women in India are not aware of this prevention. Prayas has developed 2 short films to increase awareness in the community in which veteran actress Ms Rohini Hattangadi has acted. These films were also released by Mr Praful Chandawarkar.

The films will be soon uploaded on Prayas's website and on Youtube. HPV vaccination, cervical cancer screening, colposcopy and treatment of cervical pre-cancer is available at Prayas at extremely affordable cost.

Live Life Love Life Charity Foundation believes that this mobile cervical cancer screening centre in form of an ambulance van will go a long way in making a difference to the lives of underprivileged people from our society by helping them to take the first step towards fighting cancer - detection! Prayas Health Group with the help of BMC Software and LLLLLCF together will conduct 88 camps in a year where more than 3600 underprivileged women in Pune city are expected to be screened with the WHO recommended screening and treatment protocol.
