The last quarter at Live Life Love Life Charity Foundation was extremely successful. Nag Foundation disbursed medical charity of Rs.1,75,512 for surgery, medicines and treatment and Rs. 1,78,952 for Herceptin Drug. They also started the Lymphedema Clinic and a rehabilitation Centre. Care India Medical Society reported 6 CA Breast cancer patients. Their treatment is done free of cost due to their weak economic background. Prayas team conducted 29 Cancer Screening Camps where 1440 women were screened and those with positive screening test results were treated following the WHO guidelines. They also conducted 3 awareness meetings for cervical cancer prevention in the city and its surrounding areas.

We are in deep gratitude towards all our donors, who have come forward to generously donate for this cause and also towards our beneficiaries who are doing an excellent job.

Prayas - Highlights for October 2018 to December 2018

Prayas, established in 1994, (Initiatives in Health, Energy, Learning and Parenthood) is a non-governmental, non-profit organization based in Pune, India and has been actively working in the field of cervical cancer prevention since 2010.

Live Life Love Life Charity Foundation has been facilitating a grant from BMC Software India Pvt Ltd to Prayas since 2016. In addition, Live Life Love Life Charity Foundation has provided funding support to Prayas for dubbing of the cervical cancer awareness films in Hindi and for a project on colorectal cancer screening.

Highlights Oct 2018 to Dec 2018 are as follows:

We conducted 3 awareness meetings for cervical cancer prevention. The details of which are as follows:

- On 26th November, 2018 an awareness meeting was conducted at KalwadLohgaon, Pune where 30 women were present.
- On 26th November, 2018 an awareness meeting was conducted at Nagpur Chawl, Pune where 40 women were present.
- We conducted a session on cervical cancer prevention awareness on 10th Dec, 2018 at GuruwarPeth, near Mase Ali Pune. The talk was organized by Change Makers, an NGO by Ex-Mayor MsVandanaChavan.

Live Life Love Life Charity Foundation has facilitated a grant from BMC Software India Pvt Ltd to Prayas since November 2016. Between Oct 18 to Dec 18, Prayas conducted 29 cervical cancer screening camps / outreach clinics in the community for women in the low and low and middle income strata. During these camps a total of 1440 women were screened and women with a positive screening test result were treated following WHO guidelines.
