Report of Patients (Beneficiaries of Chemotherapy)

1. Vandana Chabukswar



Age: 32 years

Diagnosis: Ca Breast (Rt) optd

Brief: She is a young patient having one boy child of 3 yrs. She is separated from her husband. She is living with her brother & father and is dependent on them for treatment for chemotherapy. Her brother works as a security guard and earns his living & takes care of his family. She lives in a non-approved slums area and is very poor. She is very needy and her prognosis is very good.

2. Anita Landge



Age: 40 years

Diagnosis: Ca Breast

Brief: She is a young patient and has two girls who are studying. Her husband works in a flour mill and earns his living. She stays in non-approved slum area & belongs to a lower middle income group locality and is very needy. She is totally dependent on her husband for treatment. Her prognosis is good.

Report of Patients (Beneficiaries of Radiation Therapy)

1) Marisanta Dsouza



Age: 69 years

Diagnosis: Ca Breast(Lt) optd

Brief: She is a housewife. She belongs to a very low income group locality. She stays in a slum area and is in need of financial help. Her sister is taking care, but for last three months she is not working. She is totally dependent on her nephew (who is a MR) for her treatment. Her prognosis is good.

Treatment Provided:

She has undergone eight cycles of Chemotherapy at Vishranti Hospital. She has to undergo 25 sittings of Radiotherapy as advised by the Doctor.

2) Kavita Devkule



Age: 42 years

Diagnosis: Ca Breast (Rt) optd

Brief: Patient is a housewife, her husband is a labourer. She lives in Solapur and has come to Pune for treatment. She comes from a lower income group. She has 3 children, two married, one working. She is dependent on her husband for her treatment. She is a very poor patient. Her prognosis is good.

Treatment Provided:

She has undergone four cycles of Chemotherapy at Vishranti Hospital. She has to undergo 20 sittings of Radiotherapy as advised by the Doctor.
