It gives us great pleasure to announce that on 27th of November, Wednesday, we have done a Charity event to collect funds for the Live Life Love Life Charity Foundation at Malaka Spice Restaurant. During this event we could collect funds upto 11 Lacs.

We are glad to inform, we are helping our 3 Implementing partners Prayas, CIMS and Nag Foundation. It gives us great pleasure to announce that in the last six months we have financially supported to 5 underprivileged patients who approached us. We are donating 40K every month to Nag foundation and donated 2 lacs to Care India Medical Society towards treatment of breast cancer and palliative care for all cancer patients.

Prayas is currently being supported by Emerson we also support them whenever they need our support.

CIMS treated 12 patients suffering from Breast cancer, Endometrial Ca. and Hodgkin's Lymphoma cancer and includes one 6 year old girl suffering from T Cell All (Blood Cancer), Chondroplasty Osteosarcoma, Tongue, Ovary, Alveolus in last six months we wish all the patients to get well soon.

The Nag Foundation is dedicated to creating a change in the health seeking behaviours of our communities. Late diagnosis is one of the causes for cancer mortality in India. Awareness about the signs and symptoms, the pathway to care and risk factors of cancer is the main focus of our awareness campaigns. Apart from creating a knowledge change we also conduct screening camps for Oral, Breast and Cervical Cancer for both men and women. Patient Aid for Surgery, Chemotherapy, Radiation, Herceptin and Immunotherapy continues to be the focus alongwith Advocacy and Survivorship. Lymphoedema therapy is provided with an inhouse machine. Dance Fit for survivors and therapies for the onco day care patients continue to benefit. Palliative Care consultancy is also provided to patients and caregivers .Our CME's and Research projects are ongoing

Nag Foundation Activities for the period from July 2024 to Dec 2024

Nag Foundation offers Palliative Care services for patients in the Oncology department at Sahyadri Hospital, Hadapsar. We register individuals who require Palliative Care, which encompasses symptom assessment, pain management, additional symptom relief, and counseling. We also provide support and counseling for caregivers. Patients receive guidance on obtaining wigs and prosthetic devices, and assistance with enrollment in Cipla Palliative Centre and Vishranti for terminal care, if needed.

We are always available for audio or video calls to offer support. The overall feedback from our patients and their caregivers is very positive, which inspires us to continue our mission of providing the best support possible with our resources.

A support group serves as a bridge between medical treatment and emotional well-being. We provide resources for patients, survivors, and caregivers to help them understand their illness and its treatment better. Emotional and psychological support eases their journey toward wellness.
