We are pleased to share that your generous support is helping us make a real difference in the lives of cancer patients through our collaboration with CIMS Hospital and the Nag Foundation

- Over the past six months, we have provided ₹6.7 lakhs in financial assistance to 7 underprivileged patients.
- Every month, we are donating ₹40,000 to the Nag Foundation towards the treatment of underprivileged cancer patients.
- We are in the process of raising funds for Mrs Sarika Sachin Kalbhor who has been diagnosed with Acute Myeloid Leukemia.

In the last six months, CIMS has successfully treated 12 cancer patients suffering from:

- Breast Cancer , · Endometrial Carcinoma, · Hodgkin's Lymphoma
- A 6-year-old girl with T-Cell ALL (Blood Cancer)
- Chondroblastic Osteosarcoma
- Cancer of the Tongue, Ovary, and Alveolus

Nag Foundation Activities for the period from Jan 2025 to June 25

Nag Foundation offers Palliative Care services for patients in the Oncology department at Sahyadri Hospital, Hadapsar. We register individuals who require Palliative Care, which encompasses symptom assessment, pain management, additional symptom relief, and counseling. We also provide support and counseling for caregivers. Patients receive guidance on obtaining wigs and prosthetic devices, and assistance with enrollment in Cipla Palliative Centre and Vishranti for terminal care, if needed.

We are always available for audio or video calls to offer support. The overall feedback from our patients and their caregivers is very positive, which inspires us to continue our mission of providing the best support possible with our resources.

A support group serves as a bridge between medical treatment and emotional well-being. We provide resources for patients, survivors, and caregivers to help them understand their illness and its treatment better. Emotional and psychological support eases their journey toward wellness.

The Patients helped since April till June are -

1. Neeti Lama is 32 year old, diagnosed with breast cancer, She comes from Manipur and currently lives with husband and 3 year old child in Pune. Her husband works as a bartender in a restaurant in Kalyani Nagar. They live alone, with their extended family living in Manipur and Nepal. She has responded very well to treatment. The patient was aided for Chemotherapy.

2. Niruma Damashan age 51 year diagnosed with CA breast, She lost her husband 5 years back, She has 4 children, 3 girls and 1 boy, 2 of her daughters are married. Her daughter and son works and supports the family. The financial aid received for the patients is making treatment possible. The patient has been helped with Chemotherapy and Trastuzumab.

3. Vaishali Patil is a 28 years young mother diagnosed breast cancer with 2 children ages 8 and 4, She hails from Pandharpur and lives with her in laws. Her husband is the sole breadwinner. They come from an agricultural background. He also works on other people's land to make ends meet. Her treatment is curative and was helped for chemotherapy. She will start Radiation shortly



Survivorship programs are available for both patient and caregivers at the hospitals, (Sahyadri Superspeciality Hospitals at Hadpasar, Deccan and Shastrinagar) and Surya Sahyadri Hospital, Kasba Peth which the foundation is associated with. The much needed Survivorship program has been well received and has helped the patients and caregivers.

Palliative care is specialized medical care for people living with a serious illness, such as cancer, it also helps patients cope with side effects of cancer. Nag Foundation has initiated Palliative Care Services, supported by Live Life Love Life Charity Foundation
